Your proxy is entitled to vote on a poll which may take place after an initial vote by a show of hands. Your proxy may not speak at the Meeting except to demand or to join in demanding a poll.
- 3. You may instruct your proxy how to vote at the Meeting. Please read the instructions on the Proxy Voting Form.
- 4. The voting date is the date of the Meeting, 25th April 2024, if voting in person, and 22nd April 2024, if voting by proxu.
- 5. In order to attend and vote at the Meeting, or appoint a proxy, you must qualify as either a shareholding member or a borrowing member under the Voting Conditions detailed below.

VOTING CONDITIONS

You are entitled to vote if you satisfy all of the following conditions numbered 1-3 below:

- 1. You are at least 18 years old on 25th April 2024.
- 2. You either:
 - (a) Have held shares to the value of not less than £100 in the Society on 31st December 2023 <u>and</u> have not ceased to hold a share or shares in the Society at any time between that date and the voting date stated in Note 4 above, or
 - (b) Owed the Society not less than £100 in respect of a mortgage debt both on 31st December 2023 <u>and</u> on the voting date stated in Note 4 above.
- 3. In the case of shares held jointly or mortgage debt owed jointly, you are the first named account holder in our records.
- 4. In addition, you can only vote once as a member, irrespective of:
 - (a) The number of accounts you hold and whether you hold accounts in different capacities (for example, on your own behalf and as a trustee), and
 - (b) Whether you qualify to vote as both a shareholding member and a borrowing member.
- **5.** Members attending the Meeting will be requested to produce evidence of membership in order to obtain admission. Please bring your latest statement of account with you as evidence of your membership. If you are appointing a proxy (other than the Chair of the Meeting), please ensure that your proxy brings an appropriate form of identification to the Meeting.

If you appoint a proxy to vote on your behalf and your proxy does not attend the Meeting, your vote will not be counted.
